#### **Administrator's Report:**

- 2018 audit is scheduled for week of April 8<sup>th</sup>. Anticipated fund balance to be lower than last year at approximately \$1.5 million. This is mainly due to additional expenses throughout 2018, as well as increased wages/fringes as employees work through steps within the pay grade system.
- Met with Clark Hill attorneys, Commissioners Heberling, Dean, County Treasurer and Drain Commissioner to discuss utilizing the County's credit to secure funding for the Black River inter-county drain and tributaries project. Clark Hill suggested placing additional funds in the revolving drain fund; which is utilized to fund drain projects until the tax assessment is collected. Currently, there is \$122,000 in the fund, which has been unchanged since 1978. Having additional funds would prevent the Drain Commission from having to borrow to fund project costs prior to tax assessment collections.
- Attended meeting last week with city managers from Sandusky, Brown City, Croswell and Marlette, as well as the village manager from Lexington to discuss issues directly impacting those entities, including savings opportunities and shared insights on common practices.
